Entries must be postmarked on or before Sept 18<sup>th</sup>, 2009. Extra fees will apply after this date. (see entry form for details)

NO e-mail or phone entries will be accepted.

Directions: easy access from US 68 in Urbana Ohio - (no parking fees for show will be required)

Wood shavings will be available for purchase on the grounds.

The following rules shall apply to all 3 shows:

1. The Open and Junior breeding shows will be sanctioned by the American Boer Goat Association (ABGA) and their rules shall govern. In case of a discrepancy or for rules not properly covered, the show committee's decision and or the judge's decision are final.
2. A Junior ABGA (JABGA) member must be under age 19 as of Jan 1st of the current calendar year.
3. The breeding classes will use the birth dates as listed on the registration certificate to determine the class divisions. The show date will be the base date to determine all ages.
4. According to the sanctioned rules by the ABGA, animals registered with the following Associations may enter in this show: American Boer Goat Association, International Boer Goat Association and Canadian Boer Goat Association. The original registration certificates will be required unless the animal is under 3 months of age then a copy of a registration application that is stamped with the date by one of the listed associations will be accepted. Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor and must have been owned by the exhibitor on or before the date of the show.
5. Animals entered in the JABGA show must be registered in the name of the JABGA exhibitor. JABGA exhibitors are responsible for showing their own animals. If the JABGA exhibitor has more than one entry in a class then the other animal(s) must be exhibited by another JABGA member.
6. All animals must be in place with all registration papers checked in with the show secretary, by 8am the day of the show. Pens will be available on a first come first serve basis.
7. If entries were received on or before the postmarked deadline then two additional animals can be added at regular fee price. If more than two animals need to be added after the deadline then double fees will apply. Substitutions are allowed. NO refunds. A \$20.00 service fee will be charged on all NSF checks.
8. All animals must be in good health. No visible signs of abscesses or any other contagious diseases (pinkeye, soremouth, ringworm etc) will be allowed. Any questionable or unhealthy animals checked by the veterinarian will be at the exhibitor's expense. The Champaign County Goat Council reserves the right to excuse any animal of questionable health.
9. All out state animals must have health papers (including recipient does) and proper tests needed by the state of Ohio. All out of state exhibitors must be at the grounds at 8am on the day of the show to have health papers checked by the veterinarian or they will not be eligible to show and will forfeit all entry fees. No health papers are required for Ohio goats.
10. All animals must comply with Ohio scrapie rules: contact the Ohio State Veterinarian at 614-469-5602.
11. The Champaign County Goat Council and/or The Champaign County Fairgrounds will not be held responsible for any loss, damages or accidents.
12. Any exhibitor, family or spectator not acting on an honorable manner will be required to leave immediately and will not be allowed to return for the remainder of the show.
13. The ABGA and JABGA shows will have class placings of first through fifth with ribbons awarded. The ABGA show will have class premiums of \$7, \$5 & \$3. The JABGA show will have class premiums of \$7, \$5 & \$3.
14. There will be no bucks shown in the JABGA show.
15. The scales for the wethers will be open from 7:00am-8:30am on the morning of the show. They will close promptly at 8:30am (or when all goats on line have been weighed). If you are not in line to be weighed by 8:30am, you will not be weighed – NO exceptions. Depending on the number of wether entries, the scales might be open the night before the show from 7:00pm to 8:00pm.
16. Camping will be available for \$20.00 per night (this includes electric and water).
